He regrets very much that you should have been annoyed by the action of various Spanish and Mexican Priests: we here, certainly, have done all that was in our power for them and no doubt we are included in their criticisms. I do not see what we can do to help you and can only suggest that you lay the matter before your own Archbishop or refer to the Bishops of the Priests in question.
